STATISTICS OF GRADUATING STUDENTS

This year, a total of **10,907** graduating students will receive their degrees, diplomas and certificates during the convocation ceremonies.

Out of this number, **5,472** will receive first degrees while **5,435** will receive postgraduate degrees. Out of the first degree graduating students, a total of **178** passed in the first class division, while **1,617** passed in the second class Upper degree, **2,496** in second class lower degree, 884 in third class, **274** in unclassified degrees in Medical Sciences and Pharmacy and **50** had pass degree. Faculty of Engineering tops with the highest number of first class degrees having **41** first class graduating students.

Also the University will graduate a total of **71** students with the Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) degrees in various disciplines.

This year, a record has been set. A graduating student in the Department of Psychology, Faculty of Social Sciences, Mr. Ayodele Daniel Dada is graduating with a CGPA of **5.00**. A perfect score. This means he scored As in all courses he took in the program. I congratulate Mr. Dada and the staff of the Department of Psychology for this feat.
